Some of their stuff I think is right on the money, just way ahead of its time. (However, that head-freezing stuff, I dunno...) The meek may inherit the earth, but the <u>Transhumans</u> will remake the galaxies in their own image. Optimism, science fictionish ideas and idealism, and grand thinking on a cosmic scale. See you at the End of the Universe Party!

Time travel with your new Hyperdimensional Resonator today!

This article from **Strange** magazine is an interview with Steven Gibbs, who purports to help others travel through time after they buy his "hyperdimensional resonators." Familiar plot elements include time cops, Grey aliens, the Philadelphia Experiment (see below), Men in Black, government coverups ("It all began when I started travelling up to Canada to help these people activate a time portal and it really made some people mad in the government...."), and the Something Terrible that's going to happen in 2012.

The American College of Orgonomy

What do orgasms, weather control, and alien space drives have in common? Wilhelm Riech discovered the Truth and, according to his followers, was crucified for it. See also the <u>Public Organomic Resaerch Exchange</u> and the <u>Wilhelm Reich Home Page</u>.

The Farsight Institute

One of the most shameless displays on the Weird Wide Web.

What's Buddha up to at the Galactic Federation? What was inside that spaceship at the heart of Comet Hale-Bopp, and what did it have to do with Atlantis, Martians, and "subspace" (a term coined on *Star Trek*)? What **really** brought down TWA Flight 800? What's the history of the Martians living under our feet--and what does the Sinister Secret Government know about them? How much money can one man bilk out of credulous True Believers and soul-traveler wannabes?

At this site, old-fashioned spiritualism is wrapped in the sheep's-clothing of scientific terminology. The Farsight Institute's "students" specialize in "Scientific Remote Viewing" (SRV), a fancy term for hypnotic trances that allow enhanced psycho-spiritual awareness of distant objects, places, and even times. What the site doesn't tell you is that "Scientific Remote Viewing" is a term from the same lexicon as "Creation Science."

According to Courtney Brown--Emory University professor (of political science), founder of the Farsight Institute and author of the goofy New Age book *Cosmic Voyage*--his people have utilized SRV to journey far and wide--from deep space (where Buddha and other ETs decide what to do with us next, and the alien-inhabited metal sphere inside Hale-Bopp utilized technology created in Atlantis) to the manipulative machinations of the U.S. Gubmint cover-ups (oh, of course) of SRV and other revelations. For \$3000 you can learn to do it too; advanced training courses costs extra.

Richard Hoagland's Enterprise Mission

Personally--in my heart of hearts---I would like nothing more than for Richard Hoagland to be right. But unlike a lot of folks, that's not enough to convince me that he's not just another kook in a suit. It seems that this rogue scientist and space conspiracy whistle-blower, Hoagland, believes that NASA stands for "No Alien Surprises Allowed." So he set up the Enterprise Mission to expose the Truths that the allegedly secretive space agency doesn't want us to know.

Chiefly, Hoagland claims to have proof that the Apollo astronauts discovered an extraterrestrial welcoming committee on the moon, that the lunar surface is crowded with alien buildings and other artifacts, and that similar artifacts on Mars possess shocking connections to ancient constructions here on Earth--and of course NASA and the Secret Sinister Government know all about them. In fact, the Enterprise Mission sponsored a seminar to reveal that NASA doctored the original Mars Pathfinder images after realizing that the first pictures (broadcast live) showed evidence of artificial objects!

Hoagland is the modern Moses behind the "Face on Mars" subgenre of space conspiracy theories, and from there he spins an almost cabalistic theory of cosmic energies and suppressed Truths that has earned him modest notoriety and a small but earnest discipleship. This site is a treat for watchers of conspiracy propogators and "respectable kooks" (those with doctorates), and a textbook case for "You see what you wish to see." Michael Unum: UFO Technology Hacker

Michael Unum is a visionary. A techno-rebel with a cause. A man who seeks to free the suppressed science of energy-efficient space drives from the clutches of those who would keep the rest of us slaves to (at least) gravity. Or maybe he's just a kook. Either way, he's

published a book, **The UFO Technology Hackers Manual**, and would like to sell you a copy. Also included here is data on propsed space drives supposedly resterd with the U.S. patent office.

Quote: "Within the unknown and the unexplained, lie the parameters for a new paradigm. As scientist, inventors, and hackers, we must go forth bravely into this new territory. If we were to turn away, to return to our comfortable ignorance, we may never do what we all dream. To advance science, technology, and human discovery to the next level."

Unum's other site, with eyebrow-raising conclusions about the HAARP project, is here.

Can sticking burning candles in your ear not only provide health benefits but make you more relaxed and centered? Look here for possible answers, but remember this site's admonition: "...almost anyone can stick a candle in your ear, what you need to watch for is professionalism." So true.

In 1943, did the U.S. Navy make the U.S.S. Eldridge disappear? Was it made invisible, teleported hundreds of kilometers, or sent into another dimension? Yes, it's the famous Face on Mars. This site is an introductory guide to this favorite Mars Mystery. Lots of internal links to related material. "Updated daily" (though not quite).

My Favorite Martian: Richard Hoagland

No collection of Cydonia links would be complete without Richard Hoagland, the techno-Moses of exo-archaeology. This introductory primer is part of the <u>50 Greatest Conspiracies of All Time</u> site, and is an even-handed write-up with related links.

More about Cydonia

A good-looking site with photos.

Mark Carlotto's Mars Page

More photos of the Cydonia "Face" and "City" from someone responsible for much of the digital enhancement of the original NASA imagery (which automatically makes them suspect to the more cautious / suspicious observers).

A Temple of the Martian Moon Gods?

Says here that the Face proves Mars was once inhabitaed by pagans. "...They worshiped sky gods. They worshiped their own moons as such sky gods..."

Planetary Anomalies

The so-called planetary proof of "tetrahedral hyperdimensional energy" is where, in my opinion, Richard Hoagland's Mars-Moon theories exit the realm of the potentially provocative and enter the Loopy Zone. Proof that a great deal of Cosmic Significance can be read into very little.

Ancient Indian Aircraft Technology

3000-years-old Jules Verne or Vindalu Space Travel, Inc.? An exerpt from **The Anti-Gravity Handbook**, now available at very few bookstores near you.

Tachyon Healing and the Physics of Love

This site at least thinks it's talking science, so I'm putting it here, though it's another example of wooly New Age feel-goodisms decorated with pseudo-scientific tinsel. It concerns an alleged new energy source, and pretends "to understand it by referencing unusual theories of advanced physics and spiritual traditions. It is hypothesized that this is the energy of crop circle formation and an embryonic clue to a coming global transformation." The connection between tachyons and crystals remains unclear.

The Apocalyptic Files

In which an attempt is made to prove that the alleged signs and portents within the Book of Revelation are predictions of modern discoveries in the physical sciences.

The Photon Belt

Astonishingly bad astronomy and physics from (<yawn>) channeled aliens. This site includes a helpful timeline of important events surrounding this Apocalyptic cosmic non-event (e.g., learn when "...our solar system will enter an interdimensional rescue bubble that will thrust it out of the photon belt ... into a position about 3 light years from the Sirius star system"). See also A Cosmic Birth: Photon Belt, for a potpourri guaranteed to muddle your medulla. And you can't go wrong by linking directly to the source, that way-out pretty-fair-seller, You Are Becoming a Galactic Human.

According to True Believers, the Photon Belt event was supposed to occur by the end of 1996, so check these sites to find out (a) why the universe changed its mind, or (b) that it all occurred on schedule but you and I were too unenlightened to notice.

Update: Recently, I've found references to the idea that the Photo Belt event timeline is being (conveniently) rescheduled due to cosmic intervention by the benign Space Brothers or miscalculations on the part of the Earthly diviners (though Sheldon Nidle is still holding to his published timeline). The favored new date for Photon Belt entry is (act surprised), 2012.

An often-updated Nidle/Photon Belt site is <u>The Ground Crew Project</u>. Keep checking it out for news of the upcoming Mass UFO Landing (millions of ships, it says here. Wowza!)

The Searl Effect

Will the Searl Effect Generator, a "magnetic prime mover...developed by Prof. Searl with his Law of the Squares philosophy to work in harmony with nature" really provide Inverse Gravity Vehicles, Atmospheric Cleansing, Radiation Eradication, Photon Energy, Desalination, and Health Rejuvination? If you think so, then send this guy your money...er, investment capital, because his miraculous machine is "under development and manufacturing mass production is expected to start before the end of the year." After all, "Prof. John R. R. Searl is offering the world new hope for a better future. He is doing this for the last time. We must be totally directed and motivated to see that Prof. Searl's gift to mankind reaches its destination." But they don't accept credit cards. And let's hope he handles science better than her does the English language; his reply to a critic--presented here--is a familiarly by-the-book example of strained "slandered genius" rhetoric and schoolyard name-calling.

UFOs and the New Physics

Lots of stuff on interstellar propulsion theories with a bent toward flying saucer engineering. Also mentions secret government projects, black helicopters, and so on.

Creation Science home page

Bad science and simplistic theology come together in this oxymoron that's still causing trouble in places such as Tennessee. In this particular Web site, these CS proponents aren't really kooks on the fringe; they're a group of engineers at AT&T Bell Laboratories, "Christians who believe strongly that people need to become better informed on this most important question of our origins." I'm a tolerant guy, but as a sometimes science writer and

educator this stuff makes me shake my head in sadness. But, to be fair, here's their (diminishing, albeit slowly) side of the debate.

Comet Hale-Bopp: Iceball, fraud, or Invasion Fleet?

I love (and <u>love to teach</u>) astronomy, and happily carry the torch of scientific orthodoxy. So there was a time, even recently, when these sorts of sites would have really gotten my dander up. These days, though, I'm mellower and bring my sense of humor to bear at times when I would have once foamed at the mouth (although astrology still makes me grit my teeth). Comet Hale-Bopp was big, bright, and observable in scopes or the naked eye for a long time, so the New Age community recognized it in their own ways. I do get a kick out of the, um, "alternative" theories regarding the comet. The Heaven's Gate tragedy was only the tip of this sad (but revealing) iceberg. Lots of WWW sites provided their unique (or dogmatically borrowed) spin on that celestial visitor. Though it's clear that some of the sites are retro-fitting their content to incorporate the fact that the Earth wasn't destroyed or the ETs didn't land (or whatever), many True Believers still refuse to give up their new gospels. Here are just a few samples:

ZetaTalk: Hale-Bopp: "The Hale-Bopp comet does not exist. It is a fraud, perpetrated by those who would have the teeming masses quiescent until it is too late....They lie, and wish to have the sheep of sci.astro take their word for the appearance of this fraud."

Even for Nancy (or, rather, her extraterrestrial brain buddies, the "Zetas"), this is a particularly lengthy and foaming rant about the conspiracy to dupe the blind sheep masses with disinformation on the "fraudulent" comet that doesn't really exist, you see, but the propaganda distracts us from the real celestial evil of the approaching "12th Planet," etcetera, etcetera... Even the **Shramek Object** (see below) is part of the Sinister Secret Government's deceptive plot. For Nancy's ongoing one-sided dialogue on this and other topics, eavesdrop on the sci.astro newsgroup.

- Beginning November '96, American radio talk shows and the Internet (naturally) were all a-twitter with reports that a "Saturn-like object" had been spotted near Hale-Bopp. True Believers immediately flooded the airwaves and burbled the bandwidth with this "proof" that the comet isn't really a comet at all, that the long-lost "12th Planet" of fringe prophecy is returning, that a giant alien starship is on its way to Earth, that the ubiquitous Government Conspiracy is covering it up, and that Chuck Shramek (see below), the innocent True Believer who "broke the veil of silence," is being crucified publicly for his paradigm-shattering heresy. It was all a bunch of hooey triggered by a faulty amateur observation and a phone call to a radio show devoted to fringe UFO beliefs. Rational thinking be damned, the whole fooforah just added fuel to an already blazing fire of high weirdness surrounding the comet. And it's still smoldering. For details of this silliness, look at this Saturn-like Object page, The SLO Files, part of a larger, most excellent Hale-Bopp site. The site also includes sometimes eye-rolling email aimed at either boosting or busting the debunkers; for that go here.
- Chuck Shramek's home page: Here it is from the man himself. Includes links to and pontifications on other related fringe sites -- a spaceship load of highly speculative hypotheses wrapped in the mantle of a martyr being persecuted by the Establishment. Now that his allotted fifteen minutes of fame have passed, Chuck's site is getting even loopier. Proof that momentary popult celebrity in any circle can blossom on the Internet. Andy Warhol was right.
- SHECHINAH: Proof that Hale-Bopp was to bring about the catastrophic destruction

of the world, and that the Sinister Secret Government has been keeping it secret for years (until the Internet spread the Word on high)! Of course there are lots of links.

- Hale-Bopp: Comet or Massive Spaceship? Found in the Cosmic Conspiracies site, this is a posting from alt.alien.visitors.
- <u>Companion to Hale-Bopp: Is it a Giant Spaceship?</u> This large site certainly seems to think so.

The maker of this site has already made up his mind on the issue. Includes a list of <u>Hollow</u> Earth Resources.

The Hollow Earth Primer

Are thousands of UFOs stashed in cold storage in deep caverns of Earth's mantle, waiting to the take over the planet and establish a new Empire? Do unearthly sentries at the poles guard the entrances to the Hollow Earth? What is Agartha, the subterranean supercivilization, like? Is the inner world threatened by the secret surface government, which is receiving help from evil "confederates of other genetic backgrounds"? Where is the gold of King Solomon and the Nazis? These are just some of the questions asked at this head-scratcher of a site.

Atlantis, Mu, and Lemuria Kingdom

Did these super-advanced civilizations perish in a global cataclysm long ago, or are they still influencing us from their subterrannean super-cities and flying saucers? Inquiring minds want to know.

Agartha: Civilizations beneath our feet

Deep in the Heart of Shasta! According to this long page, millions of enlightened beings and spirits peacefully cohabit "over 100 subterranean cities that form the [underworld] Agartha Network...While Shamballa the Lesser is an inner continent, its satellite colonies are smaller enclosed ecosystems located just beneath the Earth's crust or discreetly within mountains. All cities in the Agartha Network are physical and are of the Light, meaning that they are tradition of the great mystery schools of the surface, honoring such beings as Jesus/Sananda, Buddha, Isis and Osiris ..."

The site includes information on the capitol cities of the subterranean mega-complex, including a tourist's guide to the superior million-being metropolis inside California's Mt. Shasta.

The Hollow Earth Insider

This is an "underground magazine featuring information from a dedicated worldwide group of

Insiders researching, not only the Hollow Earth/Subterranean Mysteries, but also reports on the UFO/Alien connection and other earthly mysteries, the New World Order and other conspiracies...The One Worlders are losing their grip on the closest guarded secret in the world...our Hollow Earth."

In other words, mix old-fashioned Hollow Earth pseudoscience with modern right-wing paranoia and see what you get. They also include Hollow Moon stuff.

The International Flat Earth Society

Still active and publishing their nifty, weird newsletter. You have to admire their tenacity. Here's part of the introductory tract reproduced at this site:

"Our Society of Zetetics have existed for at least 6,000 years, the extent of recorded history. Extensive writing from 1492 b.c. We have been and are the Few, the Elite, the Elect, who use Logic Reason are Rational. Summed up,we are Sane and/ or have Common Sense as contrasted to the "herd" who is unthinking and uncaring. We have absorbed the Universal Zetetic Society of America and Great Britian, ZION U.S.A. ... Science 'proves' earth a 'ball' by 'scripture' words. We PROVE earth Flat by experiment, demonstrated and demonstrable. Earth Flat is a Fact, not a 'theory'!"

Here's where you find out how to join the organization, but be warned: "We do not want members who are stupid, mindless, brute beasts with two feet whose only aim is to scoff or in some way 'harm' our work -- Facts, Logic, Reason, Sanity also known as commonsense, is our aim."

Cyrus Teed's Inside-Out World

Here's an article from **Omni** magazine about Cyrus Teed, who prosletyzed the belief that not only is the Earth hollow, but that **we** are already living **inside** it.

Hollow Planets

Animated images reveal the "evidence" that Apollo 16 astronauts photographed the polar entrances to the Inner Earth.

The Flat Earth Society Online

Says here that "While the Society is not a 'crackpot' group, it is opposed to the fashionable, politically correct Spherical Earth theory, which is expounded every day by so-called 'scientists', the media and political leaders." This site is, in fact, a well made, on-target spoof in the "Subgenius" tradition.

Underground Apocalypse: selections from the "UFO Files" page

More than just another collection of saucer photos and reports. This site includes plenty of truly bizzarro stuff (such as a series called **Underground Nazi Invasion of the U.S.** that's 58 files long!)

Scroll way down the page and note the collection of text files describing in brain-jelling detail the Crim-Ram, or Cosmic Conflict. This fusion of Biblical interpretation and far-fringe paranoia involves ancient subterranean empires, secret societies, UFOs, the Secret Government, the assassination of Kennedy, FEMA, the conflict between Good and Evil, the serpent race (reptilians), Greys, and more, all tied together and guaranteed to purée your sense of human belief systems.

For example:

File # 001: Cosmic Confluct and the Da' Ath Wars

"... These files, along with the Judao-Christian prophesies on which they are based, could be considered a type of psychological anti-virus designed to counteract the 'virulent,' deceptive and propagandist lies which have been forced on the collective consciousness of humanity by 'certain powers,' keeping the majority of 'human sheep' blinded to the fundamental truths of reality, and forcing upon them a false perception of reality designed to keep the human spirit weak and subjected to the 'powers' behind the 'grand deception' of the 'cosmic conspiracy' as many in the know have now come to refer to it."

File # 007: Caverns, Dungeons, and Labyrinths

"... With its abundance of close-formatted text, boldface sections, piecemeal logic, and multi-limbed connections to wonky science and Judeo-Christian prophesies, this site is one of the closest electronic equivalents of those pamphlets I've found on the WWW. And like many of the old-fashioned tracts, it's difficult to tell what this thing is all about. Plus, I was stunned to find that this site is an offshoot of the theories/teachings of none other than our own A.A. Brown.

"...God is the Gravitational and electromagnetci field in which the Universe is situated. Prophets or seerers look into the future and fortell Events as fortold by God by resonating to the time tunnel or vibration in the Earth's Electromagnetic field, as modulated by the planets and the Sun. The Human body is made up of C, N, H, NH4 groups, sugar, carbohydrates, DNA, RNA, CHromosomes, Glonoids, Glands, etc which ACT AS Transistors, IC, (Integrated circuits, Resistors, capacitors, which renders the body to act and respond as a

Transponder, Broadcasting Human Radar and Computer. The brain broadcast out 'life force ' or human bio life cycle waves which is reflected by the Van Allen's Belt as (it in turn) is induced and / or modulated by the planets..."

- Are You Ready for Ascension 2012? Well, are you?
- Judgement Day: A text file detailing the 2012 "Judgement Day" and the "Harvest of people." It's definitely not what you heard about in Sunday School.
- <u>New Age: Ascension</u>: A mish-mash of New Age tropes with emphasis on the "coming dimensional shift" of 2013. (Part of the <u>Norwegian Center for Cosmic Awareness</u>, which is an even larger mish-mash.)
- Earthgate: Truly weird. "... The project will continue into the fall of 1998, but it prepares for the climax in 2012/2013, in which the Mayan calendar will end. Then the heart of the Earth will connect energetically with the Great Central Sun, a great cosmic chakra in the center of the Milky Way galaxy..."
- The Pleiadean Agenda: According to this smooshy New Age best-seller, super-nice aliens from the Pleiades star cluster (inaccurately described, by the way), are preparing us for a "Cosmic Party" that will occur on the Winter solstice of 2012. (A True Believer's review of the book appears here.)
- <u>Time travel with your new Hyperdimensional Resonator today!</u>: This bears repeating from <u>Science friction</u> above because this self-proclaimed time traveler warns us that when the Sinister Secret Government "sent scientists from the Montauk project into Earth's future, they...found that all life on the planet had been wiped out" sometime in 2012. Ooooh, scary, kids.
