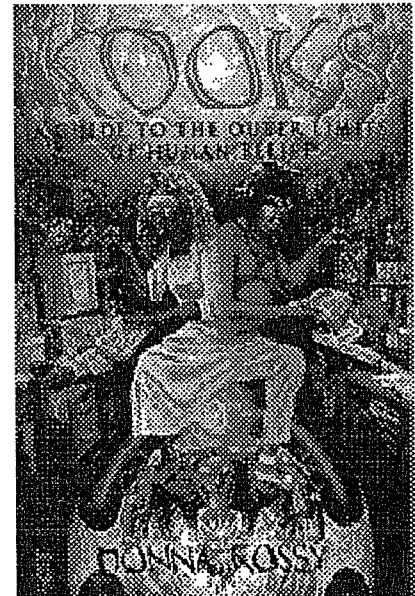

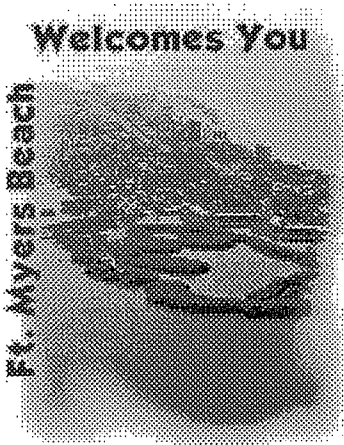

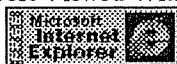
**I**n the early 1900's, the Koreshan Unity Society , a religious group, built the first structure on the south end of the island. By the early 1920's, the church fathers sold off all the land keeping one cottage for their use. The Koreshan Historical Society still owns the cottage.

**A**t the turn of the century, the only way to get to Crescent Beach was by boat. eventually some beautiful stone arches were built on San Carlos Island that led to a single lane wooden bridge. As time passed and residents increased, the arches were replaced with a swing bridge that would open to incoming and outgoing boat traffic. As the boats increased, the swing bridge was replaced with our Sky Bridge giving breathtaking views of the "World's Safest Beach."
